

More Graduation 2021 Details!

Hello Senior Parents!

First, another reminder of our graduation week events:

Monday, June 7. March Through Town, 6:30 in Camden

Tuesday, June 8. Senior Voices, 6:30 at CHRHS. **All guests and graduates must have a ticket.**

Friday, June 11. Graduation, 7:00pm. **All guests must have a ticket.**

Here are a few updates and details about these events:

The route map for the **March Through Town** is attached and paper copies are available in the main office. Students will be gathering at the Knox Mill parking lot at 5:45pm and the march will begin at 6:30pm. Students should wear comfortable clothes and walking shoes along with their caps and gowns. Masks are not required for students.

Senior Voices: Just a reminder that this free, casual event includes some of everyone's favorite parts of graduation week! Among the other items on the program, we will also be posting our traditional senior pictures under the tent so you will have an opportunity to write a message to your senior. The outside portion of this event does not require masking. The second part of the program (at around 7pm) will take place in the Strom, and all audience members are required to be masked.

Graduation Dress Code Rules: Graduation is a formal event designed to honor all graduates equally. The rules about attire and shoes are based on uniformity but also safety. Graduates will be marching over different types of terrain and up and down the bleachers. We do not want anyone to turn an ankle or fall.

If graduates intend to wear a heeled shoe, they must wear them on the first day of marching practice because we will be setting the line by height that day.

Shirts

Allowed: Dress shirts with collars and ties, dress blouses

Not Allowed: T-shirts, polo shirts

Pants

Allowed: Black dress pants

Not Allowed: Shorts, khakis, jeans

Skirts/dresses: These should not be longer than the robe, which falls at mid-calf.

Shoes: must be black

Allowed: black dress shoes, black dress boots/clogs, black sandals (which must have a strap around the ankle), black wedge heels.

Not Allowed: Shoes that are not black, sneakers, flip-flops, high-heels that are not wedges (i.e. stilettos, pumps).

Senior Voices and Graduation Tickets: In order to prepare our event spaces with the appropriate number of chairs and also to allow us to determine how many extra tickets we can distribute, please click on the link below to indicate your ticket needs. Note that we will make every effort to fill your request, but we do have a seating limit for events in the Strom. Also, we recognize that if rain is predicted for graduation day and we move the ceremony into the Strom, some students or families who are immunocompromised may not be safe or comfortable sitting with as many as 800 people in the Strom. We would like to offer those graduates and families a chance at a socially distant diploma presentation on Thursday, June 10 at 7 PM, which will be

attended by school officials and held on the stage in the Strom. This smaller ceremony will allow families to participate in pods and the family will be able to hand the graduate their diploma. If this is your preference, please RSVP for this alternate indoor rain ceremony.
