2024 Graduation

1. You must be at every marching practice, on time.
2. You must follow the dress code. If you need help getting the proper shoes or clothing for graduation, please let Ms. Munson or Ms. Self know ASAP.

Graduation Dress Code Rules (Graduation will be outdoors, weather permitting)

Shirts:

Allowed: Dress shirts with collars and ties, dress blouses

Not Allowed: T-shirts, polo shirts

Pants:

Allowed: Black dress pants

Not Allowed: Shorts, khakis, jeans

Skirts/dresses: These should not be longer than the robe, which falls at mid-calf.

Shoes (must be black):

Allowed: Black dress shoes, black dress boots, black sandals (which must have a strap around the ankle), black wedge heels not more than 2 inches high

Not Allowed: Shoes that are not black, sneakers, flip-flops, high-heels that are not wedges (ie. stilettos, pumps), crocs

Stoles/cords/etc: Only honors earned through the school can be worn at Graduation.

3. All school rules are in effect during marching practices and events leading up to commencement events. (If you are suspended for any reason, you might not march).
